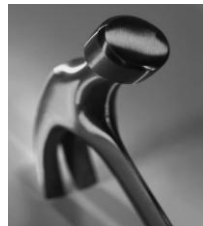
It must be noted that although the weather didn't cause physical damage during the week, it did have an impact on Family Camp. First, before camp we had been in a drought. Therefore, a burn ban was in effect which prevented any campfires. I know that affected many folks' fellowship. The weather also affected the attendance. The evening crowds were down when the storms came through. But let it be noted that final counts revealed there was an actual increase in the number of camping units in 2012 over 2011. Also, it must be mentioned that over 400 of our approximately 500 sites were reserved this year. The final impact the weather had on Family Camp that I would note right now is with our offerings. As of Wednesday night the offerings were \$407 ahead of 2011. But Thursday night is always our biggest offering, and Thursday night we had our most severe storm. Upon hearing the forecast many campers left before the storm hit, and local people stayed in for protection. Thus the result was that we ended the week over \$22,000 behind last year. We came up at least \$14,000 short of our expenses. Please make this a matter of prayer, and if you weren't able to give your offering at camp it would make a huge difference if you could mail it in the enclosed envelope.

I praise God for Family Camp this year. Many of you went out of your way to personally thank me for the work of our staff and volunteers that resulted in an excellent camp meeting. Positive comments were made all week on how good the facilities and grounds were. There was an atmosphere of genuine Christianity permeating the air. Person to Person Ministries is blessed to host this event. Please join us in regular prayer that the 2013 Family Camp would make an even greater impact for Christ.
