This edition of the newsletter is late in getting published. I personally take full responsibility for the delay. Since August 7th most of my time has been devoted to my wife, Mona. On that date she had knee replacement surgery. I had asked the Trustees for time to be with her during her surgery and subsequent recuperation. Everything went well, and she had returned home when she became very ill, and was diagnosed with pancreatitis. She was admitted to the hospital, and developed pneumonia while being treated for the pancreatitis. After fifteen days she was released but still had unresolved health issues. Just a few days after being released, on September 17th, she collapsed at home and went on to be with the Lord. I will never regret the time I took to be with Mona, and the delays on ministry projects that have occurred are relatively meaningless in the light of being with her in her final days on earth. I would like to take my article space this time to share some things that are fresh in my mind and deep in my heart pertaining to Mona and her recent passing.

I have felt pain more intensely than I ever had before
No one could have ever loved me more than Mona
God's people (and especially those connected with P2PM)
could never have been more supportive of me and
my family
My family cares for me to the point of self-sacrifice
There is true hope in Christ
I saw clearly what an impact Mona had for Christ
I am learning how much it was our ministry, not just my ministry
By God's grace one can continue on in spite of life's
circumstances
The two shall be one is a truth, not just a cliché - Half of me
is missing



As time moves on I am sure I will learn many more lessons and have many more situations that let me see how special Mona was. But already the impact of her loss is great not just to me and the family, but to P2PM and God's kingdom on earth. However, we rest on this divine truth, "Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord...so that they may rest from their labors, for their deeds follow with them."

Dear Fellow Christians,

I am writing this letter on behalf of the Trustees of Person to Person Ministries. Our message at this time is to make you aware of the financial burden soon facing Kerry Allen, our Executive Director. As many of you know, Mona Allen, Kerry's wife, passed away last Tuesday, and we were recently notified that she died of a heart attack. She had a major ordeal the last few weeks with surgery, rehabilitation and hospital stays. Kerry has medical insurance, but the policy is a \$5000 deductible plan with an 80/20 co-pay after the deductible is met. Kerry only has the bills for the initial knee replacement surgery at this time and has already met the deductible and \$3500 in co-pays. He has not received the rehabilitation statement or the last two hospital stays, one of which involved daily visits by four different specialists.

Our goal is to try and help Kerry meet his medical and funeral expenses. The ministry will do everything we can, but, we would appreciate hearing from our good friends, as well. If you would consider giving Kerry something personally beyond your regular commitments to Person to Person Ministries, it would be greatly appreciated.
